Friday, July 30, 2010

- 10:30am Rendezvous at the mouth of the Black River at the St. Clair River for cruise to St. Clair, Voyageur Restaurant for lunch, or meet us for lunch at the Voyageur Restaurant on your cruise North to Port Huron. The restaurant is on the St. Clair River and is walking distance of the St. Clair Marina.
- 5 to 6:30pm Party at Port Huron Museum's ship the Bramble, formerly owned by the US Coast Guard.
